Commitment to achieving Net Zero

At Eagle Eye Innovations, we are committed to doing our part to mitigate the impacts of climate change. As part of this commitment, we are adopting a net-zero policy that will guide our operations and help us achieve our goal of achieving net-zero carbon emissions by 2050 or sooner.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Eagle Eye Innovations Ltd have not previously assessed or reported emissions due to the size of the organisation. However, over the course of 2022 the company size increased significantly to include a 50% increase in staff and 200% increase in office space. Therefore, the baseline report below is based on data collected from September 2022 to April 2023, then estimated data to September 2023. This will then be continuously updated with actual data until 12 months has elapsed.

Emissions reduction targets

We have set the following targets to reduce our carbon emissions:

- By 2025, reduce our carbon emissions by 20% compared to our 2023 baseline.
- By 2030, reduce our carbon emissions by 40% compared to our 2023 baseline.
- By 2040, reduce our carbon emissions by 60% compared to our 2023 baseline.
- Achieve net-zero carbon emissions by 2050 or sooner.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following activities and initiatives are some examples of how Eagle Eye Innovations are reducing their GHG emissions.

- Electric vehicle (EV) scheme available to all staff which allows them to lease an electric vehicle under salary sacrifice agreements. So far, more than 12% of staff have opted for an EV. Going further, we have fitted 2 EV charging points at our Head office.
- Where appropriate electric scooters are provided for staff who are operating in remote locations. These are primarily used for scenarios where walking would be an inefficient use of time.
- The companies Tactical Operations Centre is fitted with a solar panel to enable charging from a renewable energy source.
- Staff training and policy adherence are at the forefront of our drive for more energy efficient operations. When staff are inducted, they are taken through an informative brief on energy reductions methods, which also included office closing procedures. In addition, Eagle Eye Innovations are committed to operating within the ISO 14001 standard with ambition for certification when applicable.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Cycle to work scheme
- As the range of EVs extends, we will look to use them for business travel where appropriate.
- Implement more efficient and where possible renewable energy sources on all office infrastructure. Culminating in to a transition to 100% renewable energy sources for all our operations.


This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
